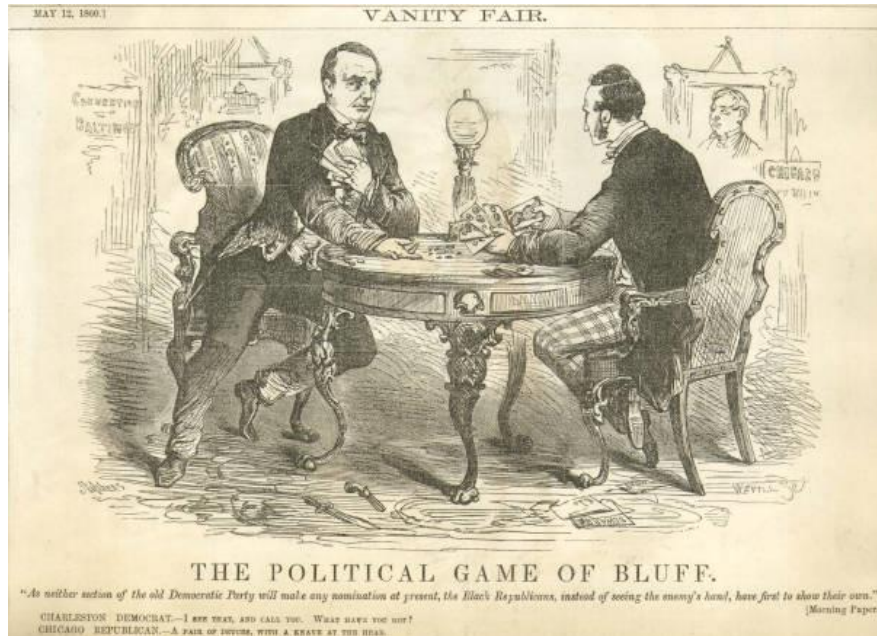


Political game or madness?

Turkey, Iran and Iraq, which is under the control of Shia militia groups, have started a new game since yesterday:

First, Erdogan launched an attack on Israel, then gave Hamas the green light to negotiate with Israel over the issue of Israeli hostages.

Erdogan, who is involved in the issue of the Kurds in Syria and Iraq, after the indiscriminate bombing of the economic infrastructure in Kurdistan-Syria and the warning of the United States of America and after it failed in the issue of Kirkuk election, is now engaged in insecurity of Kirkuk with the coordination of the Baghdad and Tehran regimes by the Sunni Arab rebels who are in Turkey, Syria and Iraq by assassinating police officers.

These people under the names of al-Qaeda, ISIS and Syrian Arab groups against Bashar al-Assad regime are in control of the Turkish Security and Intelligence Organization, which has many bases in Kurdistan-Iraq. In the report published

by Rodav website a few months ago, it mentions 33 Turkish military and spy bases in Mosul, Erbil, Dohuk.

The excuse of Erdogan's enmity with the Kurds in northern Syria is their connection with the PKK, while the Kurds in Syria reject this charge. The Syrian Democratic Government, which is in the hands of the Syrian Kurdish forces, played a key role in the ISIS war and lose 11,000 people. They run a very large prison for ISIS terrorists. There are thousands of ISIS prisoners in this prison under the supervision of American forces and its allies under the name of Centcom, and no country accepts them.

Turkey and Iran and their affiliated Iraqi forces always claim that ISIS is now destroyed and the United States should leave Iraq and Syria.

In this case, from time to time a suicide attack by ISIS against Kurdish and Iraqi military and police forces takes place in Kirkuk and Khanaqin, which are Kurdish cities under Article 140 of the new Iraqi federal constitution. Now Turkey announces that it has arrested 30 ISIS members in Turkey.

It is questionable why every time the subject of the Kurds comes up and the world condemns Turkey for the mass and systematic slaughter of the Kurds by the Turkish regime, suddenly:

Kirkuk becomes unsafe, the dormant cells of ISIS in northern Iraq become active, the Arab mercenary forces opposing the Bashar al-Assad regime become active in Afrin, Edlib and Raqqa, and the Turkish regime defends the rights of the Syrian Arab people, and some ISIS members mysteriously discover and arreste in Turkey.

The point is: if ISIS does not exist, what does the arrest of a group of them inside Turkey mean? If the Ankara regime cannot control them, why is it hostile to the Syrian Kurds, who are the natural killers of ISIS terrorists? In my opinion, it is better for Erdogan to allow the democratic Syrian government to enter Turkey and destroy ISIS!

The game this time is wider and more complicated after the harsh answer of Mr. Netanyahu, the Prime Minister of Israel, to Erdoğan, who called him the murderer of the Kurds, the perpetrator of the Kurdish genocide, and the jailer of journalists.

Erdogan is involved in a dirty game. He is in a huge surprise. Because at the Sakharov Prize awarding ceremony, the head of the European Commission honored a Kurdish girl (Jina Amini) who was killed in Tehran by the Hijab guards of the Islamic regime of Iran. In response to a journalist's question regarding the issue of Kurdistan and the rights of Kurds in countries involved in the issue of Kurds, he said: We have urged the regimes of Iran and Turkey to resolve the issue of the Kurds.

The clear position of the United States of America, Europe and Israel regarding the solution of the Kurdish issue in the Middle East has disturbed the dreams of the regimes of Iran, Turkey and Iraq. Especially Erdogan because he was able to interpret and present a threat to international security from the struggle of the Kurds to assert their national rights with the Machiavellian use of international legal tools and legal norms of the free world. But now the Turkish regime has become part of international insecurities and threats against the world order. Erdogan's behavior is very dangerous and risky.

He is trying to show himself as the hero of the Islamic world, but Muslims are human beings like the rest of the world and they need security, bread, water, prosperity and progress.

Last year, when a deadly earthquake occurred in this country, his government could not help the unfortunate people for several days. He only had a small private plane to help millions of people whose lives were ruined by the earthquake.

This shows that instead of dealing with domestic issues, Erdogan has entered into issues that are bigger than his political size and weight.

His crazy friend does the same thing in Tehran. It is interesting that the Iranian regime has recently announced that there is no such thing as an axis of

resistance and that the Palestinians, Lebanese, Houthi Yemenis, Iraqi Shiite and Sunni rebels have nothing to do with the Tehran regime.

It is interesting that Erdogan and Khamenei call these terrorists the heroes and fighters of Islam and brave freedom-seekers and justice-seekers and kiss the hands, faces, backs and faces of these terrorists, but when Israel, the United States and Europe threaten them suddenly they be silent and change the position.

Anyway, I wanted to say that these minimalist Lilliputian games show the failure of the extremist policies of the regimes of Iran and Turkey and other seditious Arab states such as Qatar, which by cultivating terrorism and disrupting networks in global security and strengthening the aforementioned terrorist groups, want to revive Islamic conquests that in Andalusia and the gates of Vienna, it was stopped.

This time, Tehran's mullahs claim that they want to hold a mourning ceremony for Ali and Hussein in the White House.

When ignorance and delusion cross the borders of stupidity, it is the embodiment of dangerous madness.
