
The Last Kurdish Trojan Horse

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A few hours ago, Abdullah Ocalan latest message and his first direct video message with members of the DEM party were broadcast on the AFN NWES channel. He declered that at one point the Kurdistan Workers' Party started the struggle to fight against the denial of the existence of the Kurdish nation and in this regard for the independence of Kurdistan, but now this goal has been achieved because the Kurdish ethnic identity has been recognized.

(So, with the recognition of the ethnic identity of the Kurds in Turkey, the attempt to establish an independent state of Kurdistan has come to an end.)

Therefore, the dissolution of this party is an imperative and signifies the end of the historical mission of this party and its struggles.

Mr. Öcalan finally declares that he is ready to hear and receive criticism in this regard.

But I personally, as a Kurd or a journalist regardless of nationality and ethnic identity, have this criticism that by acknowledging the Kurdish ethnic identity, the recognition of the national identity of the Kurds as a people who have the

"right to determine their own destiny" has not been achieved. Therefore, the dissolution of the Kurdistan Workers' Party was due to necessity. The path that this party followed was not primarily the independence of Kurdistan, but democratic confederalism, which in its essence clearly opposed the independence of Kurdistan. I asked this openly to two of the commanders of the Kurdistan Workers' Party, and they answered me in the presence of a group of members of the Kurdistan Democratic Party: Democratic confederalism has been established and approved in the PKK manifesto as a model for replacing nationalist activities.

They said that there is no place for nationalism in democratic confederalism. Therefore, the end of the PKK's activities as an independence party is a propaganda or a fallacy on the part of Mr. Ocalan. Therefore, Kurdish nationalist ideas with an approach to the independence of Kurdistan, as I have written before, have had no place in the PKK's political culture for many years, so claiming its end today is useless and meaningless.

Regardless of all this, the right to self-determination for the Kurdish people is still reserved and they have the right to have an independent country and to take their place in the world order and govern themselves, not to be a threat to other countries, whether far or near, and also to have the right to defend their identity, national interests and traditions based on the United Nations Charter. Yes! The PKK is over, but the Kurdish people are also alive and the land of Kurdistan is a geographical and historical political reality and as I said, the right to self-determination for the independence of the historical land of Kurdistan in the Middle East is reserved.

But the concept that Mr. Öcalan has about the individual and the ploral and their relationship with each other and that the right of one person is crystallized in the right of the group, it is the use of the same outdated Marxist-Leninist literature that does not recognize individual freedoms. Using this excuse, he is trying to "aknowledging Kurdish identity" in the sense of recognizing Kurdish national independence.

I have to say this sentence forever, the disaster and calamity that the ideology of Islam and communism has brought on the fate of the Kurdish nation and on the geography of Kurdistan is very terrible, and unfortunately, people like Abdullah Öcalan, Ali Qaradaghi, the Barzanis, the Talabanis, the Geilanis, the Kurdish reformists, the Muhtadis and the successors of Sharafkandi in the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iran created misery and self-destruction, poverty and destruction for the innocent people of Kurdistan. Their legacy was failure and division and death and life in the shadow of insecurity and displacement for intellectuals, thinkers, artists, academics and elites of the Kurdish nation. They were the Trojan Horse of the Persian, Turkish, and Arab occupiers.

But Kurdistan is always alive, and the issues of this period are all moving forward for the benefit of this ancient and oppressed nation.

As I said and wrote earlier, the dissolution of this party was not due to the realization of its ideals, because the word "Kurd" has been free in Turkey for years, but what is still banned is the word "Kurdistan," because this word implies an ethnic identity with political, historical, and cultural geography.

The PKK entered into equations and transactions that practically involved it with the interests of the free world and with the identity threat of Israel, the United States and free Europe. It was in close contact with the Shiite regimes of

Iran, Syria and Iraq, and also many of its high-ranking cadres were agents of the Turkish security organization.

The PKK, especially since the time of Cemil Bayk, entered into complex interactions with the Iranian regime, which were considered part of the axis of fake resistance of the Iranian regime and the Shiite crescent.

The PKK is now part of the Iraqi Hashd Al Sha'bi, which was established in Najaf by the fatwa of the world's highest Shiite religious authority, Ali al-Sistani.

The Shiite Crescent is the foundation of the Iranian regime's fake resistance axis, the sparks of which are spreading all over the world. Hamas and Islamic Jihad are not Shiites and are not part of the Shiite Crescent, but they are the front or arrowhead of the fake resistance axis of this hellish regime. This is why the Iranian regime, using the ideology of global anti-Semitism, cleverly leads anti-Israeli movements under the slogan of fighting for the rights of the Palestinians with the strategy of "Palestine from the river to the sea", which is the destruction of Israel, and the scope of this strategy has also extended to international American universities such as Harvard.

On the other hand, the Iranian regime, by creating lobbying organizations such as NAIAC and others, promotes the slogan of "turning the White House into a Shiite Husseiniya." This regime has prevented the implementation of practical pressure on the Iranian regime for years, using its overt and covert lobbying to the point where people like Robert Malley, John Kerry, Wendy Sherman, Barack Obama, Kamala Harris, and even people like Tucker Carlson have all become defenders of this regime and, to the amazement of everyone and in front of the eyes of the people of the world, have given this terrorist regime unlimited and international political credibility. For thirty years and more, they have turned a blind eye to the terrorist activities of this regime, as well as the construction of

this nuclear bomb. The propaganda that these people's associates carried out in the American media was unimaginable, and they are still trying to preserve this regime.

But the PKK and the Kurdistan issue have nothing to do with each other. The other parties in Kurdistan have nothing to do with the Kurdish issue, they only carry the word Kurdistan around with them, but they are empty of meaning, and they are all aligned with the Iranian regime. Even Abdullah Muhtadi's connection with Hillary Clinton and the Georgetown University incident two years ago do not diminish his dependence on the Iranian regime. They all condemned the Israeli attack on Iran and declared their non-alignment with Israel. They think that Israel is separate from the United States, and therefore they try to pretend that they have not made any miscalculations if they deny or condemn Israel or declare neutrality.

Except for the Syrian Democratic Front movement led by General Mazloum Abdi, which has not denied ties with Israel in an interview, all Kurdish parties in all countries have denied ties with Israel, and some, like the PKK, are fundamentally opposed to the Free World Front led by the United States of America.

Therefore, the leaders of the Kurdish parties, not the Kurdish nation, made a miscalculation and lost the game, and we will soon see the dissolution of other Kurdish parties, because when a political movement loses its meaning, it is destroyed. But the Turkish regime is never happy and many sorrows will befall it in the near future, because with the changing situation in the Middle East, this regime must fold its legs and arms and wait for what great developments will overwhelm it internally.

But Iran and Iraq, the Shiite Arab-Ajam brothers! They must pay for the blood of American soldiers they have shed since 2003.... Yes! Because the one who

sits in the White House and rules the world is a strong eagle that plucked its beak, talons, and feathers so that new and strong beaks, talons, and feathers will grow from its body again and it will begin a new era in its life, just like in its youth when it saw a grain of wheat from the sky amidst the sand on the ground. Yes! The United States of America is the awe of God on earth. It is the hand of the living invisible God that moves things forward.
